



What to expect with the launch of TAI 4.0

No 3.8 release, Revised End of Life (EOL) cycle

Customers who have been with us for a while have grown accustomed to our annual upgrades. However, this year, with the release of TAI 4.0, we will not be releasing a version 3.8 this fall.

As announced at the 2021 TAI User Group, TAI 4.0 will offer increased breadth and depth of functionality and an enhanced user experience. We will continue to share more about this exciting new release as it rolls out. In the meantime, here are some important details about the upgrade process:

Users of TAI Release 3.6 or Less who are NOT planning to upgrade directly to TAI 4.0: TAI 3.7 will still be available for those who wish to upgrade. However, users will need to move directly to 3.7, as earlier versions will no longer be available as an upgrade.

Mainframe Users: Except for minor patch releases, TAI 3.7 is the last version available for the Mainframe system. End of support for TAI Mainframe is currently set for 2027. Mainframe clients who would like to upgrade to TAI .NET should reach out to [Nicole Karfakis](#) or Brian Traxler.

Revised End of Life (EOL) Cycle: We have extended EOL for TAI 3.2 clients for an additional year.
